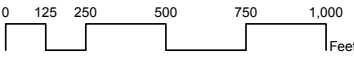

This map incorporates the current (10-2014) Mendocino County Assessor's Parcel Map lines within the Mendocino Town Plan Boundaries. The parcel lines as portrayed are for tax purposes only, and should not be construed as representing legal lot boundaries.

The Town of Mendocino boundary along the Pacific Ocean, Mendocino Bay, and tidal lower Big River follows the shoreline. (Government Code Section 23123).
