NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING FOR SUBMITTAL OF STATE CDBG APPLICATION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors will conduct a public hearing on November 14, 2017 at 9:00 am, or as soon thereafter as the item may be heard, at 501 Low Gap Road, Ukiah, CA 95482 in order to discuss the submittal of an application in response to the 2017 State Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA), and to solicit citizen input.

The Planning and Building Services Department on behalf of the County of Mendocino is applying for a grant in the amount of up to \$4,837,500 and the approval to expend approximately \$160,000 in existing or anticipated Program Income under the NOFA for the following eligible activities:

Public Facility Project –
Mental Health Crisis Stabilization Unit and Crisis Residential Treatment....\$4,500,000
General Administration.....\$337,500

The purpose of the public hearing is to give citizens an opportunity to make their comments known on the proposed activities/application.
