RESOLUTION OF THE MENDOCINO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS APPROVING NOTICE OF COMPLETION AND RELEASE OF CONTRACT SURETY, DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION CONTRACT NUMBER 170002, 2017 ROUND VALLEY AIRPORT EMERGENCY VEHICLE PARKING AREA PAVING (COVELO AREA)

WHEREAS, by Resolution Number (No.) 17-049 adopted April 4, 2017, the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors authorized the Department of Transportation (DOT) to advertise and award DOT Contract No. 170002; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 17-073 adopted June 6, 2017, the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors authorized DOT to advertise and award DOT Contract No. 170002, in an amount greater than previously authorized; and

WHEREAS, on June 7, 2017, DOT awarded DOT Contract No. 170002 to Mendocino Construction Services, Inc., of Willits, California, for 2017 Round Valley Airport Emergency Vehicle Parking Area Paving; and

WHEREAS, final inspection and submission of contract records for the construction activity on the project was made pursuant to the Recommendation for Acceptance and filing of Notice of Completion accompanying this resolution; and

WHEREAS, Section 9204 of the California Civil Code provide that a public entity may record a notice of completion on or within 15 days after the date of completion of a work of improvement, and Section 9200 provides that completion of a work of improvement occurs at the earlier of the acceptance of the work of improvement by the public entity or the cessation of labor on the work of improvement for a continuous period of 60 days; and

WHEREAS, Section 9356 of the California Civil Code provides that a stop payment notice is not effective unless given before the expiration of 30 days after the recordation of a Notice of Completion; and

WHEREAS, Section 9558 of the California Civil Code provides that a claimant may commence an action to enforce the liability on a payment bond no later than six months after the period in which a stop payment notice may be given under Section 9356 of the Civil Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors:

- Accepts the completed work, approves the form of Notice of Completion, and authorizes the Director of Transportation to execute the Notice of Completion for DOT Contract No. 170002 and file it with the County Recorder; and
- 2. Authorizes and directs the Director of Transportation to release, in accordance with the following schedule, the contract bonds filed by the contractor, Mendocino Construction Services, Inc., PO Box 1517, Willits, CA 95490, pursuant to the provisions of DOT Contract No. 170002 executed June 23, 2017; and
- 3. Authorizes and directs the Director of Transportation to release, thirty days from the date of recordation of Notice of Completion, upon confirmation with the Clerk of the Board and the Auditor, no claims or lawsuits have been filed against same, the Performance Bond (No. 106738636) in the amount of \$51,705.00 issued by

Travelers Casualty and Surety Company of America, One Tower Square, Hartford, Connecticut, 06183; and

4. Authorizes and directs the Director of Transportation to release, thirty days plus six months from the date of the recordation of Notice of Completion, providing no claims or lawsuits have been filed against same, the Labor and Materials Bond (No. 106738636) in the amount of \$51,705.00 issued by Travelers Casualty and Surety Company of America, One Tower Square, Hartford, Connecticut, 06183.
