To Whom It May Concern:

Please take notice that Covelo Fire Protection District has submitted its resolution to the Board of Supervisors to change its regularly scheduled district elections for governing board members from odd-numbered years to even-numbered years so that said elections are consolidated with the statewide general election that takes place during November in even numbered years. Covelo Fire Protection District has adopted a resolution to move its respective district elections to even-numbered years starting in 2020. A copy of the resolution requesting the change is attached to this letter.

Please take further notice that the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors will consider and possibly approve the request of the district identified in this letter during the Board of Supervisors' meeting on January 2, 2018. Please provide input to the Mendocino County Clerk of the Board by December 26, 2017, 2017, as to the effect that this consolidation may have on your district.
