• Branscomb Road, County Road (CR) 429, at Milepost (MP) 17.21, 2017 Storm Damage (Federal Highway Administration [FHWA] – Emergency Relief) Repair Project Construction Contract: Pursuant to Board Resolution No. 17-064 (May 16, 2017), bids for MCDoT Contract Number (No.) 170049, 2017 Storm Damage on Branscomb Road, CR 429, at MP 17.21 were opened as scheduled on Thursday, February 1, 2018. Bouthillier's Construction of Willits, California, was deemed the apparent "low bidder" for this project with a bid of \$360,730.00. The Engineer's Estimate for the contract was \$452,160.00.

• Orr Springs Road, CR 223, at MP 39.20, 2017 Storm Damage FHWA – Emergency Relief Repair Project Construction Contract: Pursuant to Board Resolution No. 17-064 (May 16, 2017), bids for MCDoT Contract No. 170023, 2017 Storm Damage on Orr Springs Road, CR 223, at MP 39.20 were opened as scheduled on Thursday, February 1, 2018. Bouthillier's Construction of Willits, California, was deemed the apparent "low bidder" for this project with a bid of \$432,444.00. The Engineer's Estimate for the contract was \$648,660.00.

There will need to be a complete road closure of at least five days. MCDoT is striving for a Monday to Friday closure in order to be open by the weekend. In addition, there will be up to a ten day partial closure while the temporary Bailey Bridge is dissembled. It is anticipated that half of the tieback pile wall can be constructed next to the bridge and backfilled in order to form a single traffic lane. Then the process of deconstruction of the temporary Bailey Bridge can be accomplished off to the side so that a portion of the ten day partial closure can be kept to only midday, with one lane open overnight, and on weekends, to allow for a normal morning and evening commute during the day. • Road Closure: Robinson Creek Road, CR 125, at MP 1.52, on Monday March 5<sup>th</sup>, 2018, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m., and Road Delays from 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.: The County's Geotechnical Engineer, in support of storm damage repair design, is doing subsurface drilling and needs to block the road to drill soil log borings. This work requires that MCDoT close the road between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m., and then to expect 20 minute delays between 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. The road will be closed to large trucks all day except between 12:30 and 1:00 p.m. Residents cannot detour, so access restrictions will need advance planning by residents. Notification will be made via social media, and, signs will be placed around the MP 1.52 closure to provide advance notice to local traffic of the impending closure.

The road will be closed to large trucks all day both days, except between 12:30 and 1:00 p.m. Residents cannot detour, so access restrictions will need advance planning by residents. Notification will be made via social media, and, signs will be placed around the MP 4.52 closure to provide advance notice to local traffic of the impending closure.

• Road Closure: Low Gap Road, CR 223, at MP 19.40, on Thursday, March 8<sup>th</sup>, 2018, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.; then Road Delays from 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m., and on March 9<sup>th</sup>, from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.: The County's Geotechnical Engineer, in support of storm damage repair design, is doing subsurface drilling and needs to block the road to drill soil log borings. This work requires that MCDoT close the road on Thursday, March 8<sup>th</sup>, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m., and to expect 20 minute delays between 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. on March 8<sup>th</sup>, and from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on March 9<sup>th</sup>. The road will be closed to large trucks all day both days, except between 12:30 and 1:00 p.m. Residents cannot detour, so access restrictions will need advance planning by residents. Notification will be made via social media, and, signs will be placed around the MP 19.40 closure to provide advance notice to local traffic of the impending closure.

This work requires that MCDoT close the road between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. beginning March 28<sup>th</sup>, until March 29<sup>th</sup>, 2018. Residents can detour via Little River Airport Road. Notification will be made via social media, and, signs will be placed around the MP 0.50 closure to provide advance notice to local traffic of the impending detour.

• Road Closure: University Road, CR 116B, at MP 3.78, on Friday, April 6<sup>th</sup>, and Monday April 9<sup>th</sup>, 2018, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. and then 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.: The County's Geotechnical Engineer, in support of storm damage repair design, is doing subsurface drilling and needs to block the road to drill soil log borings. This work requires that MCDoT close the road between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on April 6<sup>th</sup>, and 9<sup>th</sup>, 2018. The road will be closed to large trucks all day both days, except between 12:30 and 1:00 p.m. Residents cannot detour, so access restrictions will need advance planning by residents. Notification will be made via social media, and, signs will be placed around the MP 3.78 closure to provide advance notice to local traffic of the impending closure.

• Road Closure: Old Toll Road, CR 108, at MPs 3.13 & 3.31, on Tuesday, April 10<sup>th</sup>, to Friday, April 13<sup>th</sup>, 2018, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.: The County's Geotechnical Engineer, in support of storm damage repair design, is doing subsurface drilling and needs to block the road to drill soil log borings. This work requires that MCDoT close the road between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. beginning April 10th, until April 13th, 2018. Residents can detour via Lake County. Notification will be made via social media and signs will be placed around the MP 3.13 and MP 3.31 closure to provide advance notice to local traffic of the impending detour.
