**REQUEST:** The Mendocino County Board of Supervisors proposes to amend Mendocino County Code Chapter 20.242.040 Table 1, Medical Cannabis Cultivation Site, to the Inland Zoning Ordinance (Mendocino County Code, Title 20, Division I), which is administered by the Department of Planning and Building Services. Summary: This Ordinance makes changes to Section 20.242.040 to delete certain references to the Rangeland (RL) zoning district to clarify that no administrative permit is required for expansion of existing cannabis cultivation sites in the Rangeland (RL) zoning district up to the maximum amount of cultivation allowed for each cannabis cultivation permit type.
