


# COMPUTERS ARE ESSENTIAL FOR TODAY'S YOUTH

- Reduces anxiety, communication and control with adults
- Increases access and efficiency with resources
- Valuable resource in school, college & work
- Increases participation in community
- Every youth, no matter their career path, needs a fundamental level of technological competence
- More than 50% of today's jobs require some degree of technology skills; will increase to 77% in next decade

#### YOUTH ACCESS TO COMPUTERS

American foster youth rank in the bottom third of all countries in access to computers.



#### PROGRAM CONTRIBUTING PARTNERS



# LAPTOPS DESIGNED BY MICROSOFT & INTEL

- Semi-Rugged Design light-weight design with shock-proof flash, more durable to bumps & occasional drops
- Internet Ready Wi-Fi enabled, Bluetooth enabled & HDMI ready
- Live tech support available & iFoster will conduct check ins within first 90 days
- Access to TAY Assistant & Digital Locker

## **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

- Age 16-21 with an open foster care case with either Family & Children's Services or Juvenile Probation
- Cannot have another laptop
- Must have social worker/probation officer approval (& caregiver approval for minors)
- Must complete I laptop agreement
- Not all youth will be eligible for laptop for various reasons (court orders, safety issues, incarcerated, etc.)



### MENDOCINO COUNTY



- Will receive up to 42 laptops based on County staff verification of eligibility.
- Distribution event with iFoster representatives will occur during the Independent Living Skills class at The Arbor Youth Resource Center on June 12<sup>th</sup>.
- Mendocino County eligible youth who are unable to attend due to work or school or who live out of the area will receive a laptop individually from their social worker/probation officer.
