

MONITORING COMMUNITY HEALTH



EpiCenter Health Monitoring Software provides:

- Emergency room and hospital admissions in real time to detect disease outbreaks
 - Notification of unusual disease complaints in a region
 - Insight into cyclical trends of disease complaints
 - Historic baseline for assessment of events
- Food borne illnesses
- Drug overdoses
- Animal bites and rabies outbreaks

Public Health Accreditation

What is Public Health Department Accreditation?

• The measurement of health department performance against a set of nationally recognized, practice-focused and evidencedbased standards.

• The issuance of recognition of achievement of accreditation within a specified time frame by a nationally recognized entity.

• The continual development, revision, and distribution of public health standards.
