Please keep the operations of the library, which are healthy, functional and continuing to grow and improve, separate from the museum Definitely the museum needs improved oversight but we should designate specific resources to focus on that set of needs that are commiserate with its function in our community, and not allow it to jeopardize the success of another important local institution.
