RE: ADOPTION OF RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND AWARD DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION CONTRACT NUMBER 180010 TO PERFORM A 2018 ASPHALT CONCRETE MAINTENANCE PROJECT ON VARIOUS COUNTY MAINTAINED ROADS (REDWOOD VALLEY, CALPELLA, UKIAH, AND HOPLAND)

Honorable Board Members:

This Mendocino County Department of Transportation (MCDOT) Contract Number (No.) 180010 will provide for road pavement preservation treatment of a Cold In-Place Recycle followed with a Chip Seal on the following County Roads (CR):

Total Length: 7.58 miles

This project is to be constructed through the use of Road Funds in Budget Unit (BU) 3041. BU 3041 has \$2.0M budgeted, with \$1M from Cannabis or other general funds as directed by the Board and \$1M from road maintenance funds, including all available Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Accounts funds. The Department will not exceed funding available.

MCDOT intends to advertise for bids and have this project completed this calendar year. MCDOT will prepare construction plans, specifications, estimates and contract documents, advertise and award a County contract, and coordinate the project with the other governmental agencies.


I recommend and request that the Board authorize and direct the Director of Transportation to advertise for construction bids and to award a MCDOT contract, up to \$2.1M, to perform the 2018 Asphalt Concrete Maintenance Project on Various County Maintained Roads. Total distance to be treated is estimated to be 7.58 miles but, the distance treated could be adjusted depending on bids received. If needed, reductions in miles of roadway treated will be made.

The Director is also making an Assembly Bill 720 declaration, that MCDOT crews will do approximately \$750,000 in preparation (dig outs) and pavement marking for this corrective maintenance project (MCDOT Contract No. 18010), as well as, additional crew efforts this year on corrective maintenance.

Department of Transportation staff personnel have prepared a draft Resolution which provides said authorization for the Board's consideration and adoption.
