The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) proposes to provide remedial measures to minimize recreational user exposure to lead-impacted soil on private property parcels located beneath and adjacent to the Salmon Creek Bridge on State Route 1 between post miles 42.4 and 43.3 in Mendocino County. The interim clean-up measures are being proposed to focus on the currently utilized unpaved private access road, parking area, and the adjacent exterior areas of the residence to prevent further exposure and tracking of lead-contaminated soils into the residence. The interim clean-up measures at the site warrants immediate action to minimize potential exposure to elevated lead concentrations in the soil. The following items are enclosed for your review:

- Time-Critical Removal Action Workplan Residential Parcels dated February 2018
- Boundary Determination prepared by California Coastal Commission staff
- Site Plan (Figure 4 from the Workplan)

A check in the amount of \$1,207 will be submitted separately.

Pursuant to Public Resources Code Section 30601.3, Caltrans is requesting that the project be consolidated and processed by the California Coastal Commission as the project crosses both state and local jurisdictional boundaries.
