**RESOLUTION OF THE MENDOCINO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS APPROVING
THE REDWOOD COMPLEX FIRE SIDELETTER OF AGREEMENT**

WHEREAS, Mendocino County experienced devastating wild fires resulting in the loss of hundreds of homes from the Redwood Complex Fire; and

WHEREAS, the Board, in response to this devastating wild fire desires to approve an Emergency Leave Donation and Emergency Vacation Cash-Out; and

WHEREAS, the Memoranda of Understanding between the Mendocino County Employee Bargaining Units do not contain provisions related to emergencies such as the Redwood Complex Fire; and

WHEREAS, the Board intends that this leave is available to all employees directly impacted by the Redwood Complex Fire regardless of their bargaining unit; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Mendocino find this agreement to be proper and suitable.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Redwood Fire Complex Sideletter (shown on Attachment A and incorporated here in) is in effect as of October 8, 2017 and until June 30, 2018, for the emergency resulting from the Redwood Complex Fire, and is subject to agreement from each Mendocino County Employee Bargaining Units.




