**REQUEST:** The Mendocino County Board of Supervisors proposes to amend Mendocino County Code Chapter 20.243 Cannabis Facilities and Chapter 6.36 Cannabis Facilities Businesses of the Inland Mendocino County Code. Making multiple changes to the ordinances including but not limited to making the chapters apply to both Medical and Adult Use Cannabis Businesses.

**ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:** Section 15061(b)(3)- General Rule Exemption

**LOCATION:** All unincorporated inland areas within Mendocino County. The areas not included are, the city limits of Ukiah, Fort Bragg, Willits and Point Arena. Zoning restrictions of Chapter 20.243 are applicable only to the Inland Zone Areas of the County.

**PLANNING COMMISSION RECOMMENDATION:** The Planning Commission, at their April 5, 2018 meeting, recommended that the Board of Supervisors approve Ordinance Amendment No. OA 2018-0005 which will modify Chapters 6.36 and 20.243 of the Mendocino County Code, with modifications and suggestions as specified in the Commission's resolution, and finding that the actions as proposed do not have the potential to cause a significant effect on the environment, and

is therefore not subject to CEQA pursuant to the General Rule Exemption of Section 15061(b)(3) of the CEQA Guidelines.

**SUMMARY:** This ordinance is making several updates, revisions and additions to various sections of Chapters 6.36 and 20.243 of the Mendocino County Code regarding the County's cannabis facilities business licenses and zoning requirements for cannabis facilities. Proposed amendments include modifying the chapters to apply to both medical and adult use cannabis facilities, changes to better align the terms and definitions of the ordinance with those of State law and regulations, and changes regarding administrative permit and zoning requirements.
