

My term on the Mendocino County Planning Commission as At Large Forestry Representative will expire on June 3, 2018 and I will not be seeking reappointment. Serving the last four and one half years has been very interesting, fulfilling and an honor. You are lucky to have a Planning Commission that functions so well together and is so productive by receiving the able assistance from an effective Staff.

Forestry in Mendocino County is still a mainstay regardless of the current changes and shifts in income generation that may or may not be sustainable. The trees will continue to grow no matter what. I anticipate you remain committed to having a person knowledgeable in Forestry to represent this segment of the County's productive capacity. Therefore I would like to recommend a replacement. Michael Howell has been RPF #2030 since 1982 and is unquestionably knowledgeable in Forestry. He has practiced Forestry as a Forester for Masonite and an independent consultant since 1975. He is also one of the family owners of the Perry Gulch Ranch which is a 1,000 acre tree farm near Navarro.
