RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AUTHORIZING THE AGRICULTURAL COMMISSIONER TO EXECUTE A COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT WITH THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF FOOD AND AGRCIULTURE FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF DETECTION ACTIVIES RELATED TO THE EUROPEAN GRAPEVINE MOTH PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA) Pest Detection/Emergency Projects Branch operates a statewide detection trapping program for the eradication of serious agricultural pest from California; and

WHEREAS, CDFA enters into cooperative agreements with County Agricultural Commissioners related to CDFA compliance and detection activities; and

WHEREAS, CDFA desires to enter into a cooperative agreement with the Mendocino County Agricultural Commissioner's Office for the Agricultural Commissioner to provide European Grapevine Moth detection trapping activities for the term of January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2018; and

WHEREAS, under the proposed agreement, CDFA will reimburse the County of Mendocino in the amount of \$129,394; and

WHEREAS, the Mendocino County Agricultural Commissioner is requesting authorization from the Board of Supervisors to enter into a Cooperative Agreement (agreement) with CDFA and execute the agreement, any amendments thereto that do not increase the maximum total amount of the agreement, and provide any assurances or certifications required to enter into the agreement and is designated to represent the County in carrying out the County's responsibilities under the agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors do hereby authorize Harinder Grewal, Mendocino County Agricultural Commissioner and Sealer, to sign and execute a Cooperative Agreement with the California Department of Food and Agriculture, any amendments thereto that do not increase the maximum total amount of the agreement, and provide any assurances or certifications required to enter into the agreement, and is designated to represent the County in carrying out the County's responsibilities under the Cooperative Agreement.
