Department Update

- The Cannabis Unit held four workshops during July and August in Ukiah, which were well attended by individuals seeking help with the permitting process. The next workshop will be held Thursday, August 23, 2018, from 12:30 to 3:30, at the Department of Agriculture Large Conference Room. Due to the success of these workshops, staff is planning to schedule additional meetings outside of Ukiah within the next month.
- The first phase of permit renewals is underway. Notifications are being sent to permittees via email and USPS mail. Revised applications and related forms will be available on the County website beginning September 4, 2018.
- Department staff is seeking data to determine potential crop loss due to the Mendocino Fire. At this time, there have been no reports of loss or damages.
