ORDINANCE OF THE MENDOCINO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AMENDING TITLE 10 – ANIMAL CARE AND CONTROL

This ordinance is making several updates and revisions to various sections of Title 10 of the Mendocino County Code regarding the County's regulation of Animal Care and Control. Proposed amendments include creating a uniform hearing procedure for animal related hearings, replacing the Department of Animal Care and Control an Animal Care and Control Appeals and Advisory Board with a hearing officer, updating the code to reflect the division of Animal Care Services and Animal Control and including a microchipping requirement for impounded animals and restrictions on the maintenance of feral cat colonies.
