RESOLUTION OF THE MENDOCINO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS APPROVING DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AGREEMENT NUMBER 190049 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$112,150 WITH AND ACCEPTING THE HIGHWAY EASEMENT DEED CONVEYING REAL PROPERTY FROM PINOLEVILLE POMO NATION, FOR THE ACQUISITION OF RIGHTS OF WAY NEEDED FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE ACKERMAN CREEK BRIDGE REPLACEMENT ON NORTH STATE STREET, COUNTY ROAD 104, MILEPOST 0.97, PROJECT NUMBER A-1101, (UKIAH AREA)

WHEREAS, the County of Mendocino seeks to acquire certain real property owned by Pinoleville Pomo Nation, hereinafter referred to as OWNER, said real property being necessary to provide adequate rights of way for the removal and replacement of the existing bridge over Ackerman Creek on North State Street, County Road (CR) 104, milepost (MP) 0.97, designated Department of Transportation (DOT) Project Number (No.) A-1101; hereinafter referred to as PROJECT; and

WHEREAS, the OWNER has signed the following right of way DOT Agreement No. 190049 and related Highway Easement Deed, which DOT Agreement and Highway Easement Deed are attached to a letter accompanying this resolution, in which the County of Mendocino agrees to acquire from the OWNER and the OWNER agrees to convey to the County, for the dollar amount stated above, the rights of way needed for the PROJECT, subject to the performance of certain conditions on the part of the County of Mendocino, said conditions being set forth in full in DOT Agreement listed above submitted to this Board for acceptance and approval; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Transportation has reviewed the DOT Agreement listed above and recommends it for approval; and

WHEREAS, County Counsel has reviewed the DOT Agreement listed above and has approved it as to form; and

WHEREAS, a Highway Easement Deed, by reference made a part hereof, conveys real property from OWNER to the County of Mendocino, in accordance with the terms of the DOT Agreement listed above; and

WHEREAS, said Highway Easement Deed conveys to the County of Mendocino real property that the County requires for DOT Project No. A-1101, to remove and replace the Ackerman Creek Bridge on North State Street, CR 104 at MP 0.97.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors hereby:

- 1. Authorizes and directs the Chair of the Mendocino County of Board of Supervisors to execute the DOT Agreement to acquire real property from the OWNER; and
- 2. Accepts the Highway Easement Deed from the OWNER conveying real property to the County of Mendocino, subject to the performance of certain conditions on the part of the County of Mendocino, said conditions being set forth in full in the DOT Agreement; and

- 3. Authorizes and directs the Chair of the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors to execute the Statutory Certificate of Acceptance in connection with said Highway Easement Deed; and
- 4. Directs the Clerk of the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors, upon execution of the Statutory Certificate of Acceptance, to submit the Highway Easement Deed to the County Department of Transportation office for further processing and recording; and
- 5. Authorizes and directs the County Auditor and the County Assessor to prorate and transfer taxes as of the date of recording of said Highway Easement Deed conveying certain real property of OWNER to the County of Mendocino, pursuant to Section 4986 of the Revenue and Taxation Code of the State of California.
