SUBJECT: County Investment Policy

The Mendocino County Investment Policy is being submitted herewith for approval by the Board of Supervisors. This policy is in conformance with all pertinent California Government Codes, which also recommend that the policy be submitted annually for approval by the Board of Supervisors. Per Government Code §53646, the Treasurer may annually render to the Board of Supervisors a statement of investment policy, which the Board shall review and approve at a public meeting.

Per Government Code §53600.5, the primary objective of a trustee shall be to safeguard the principal of the funds, the secondary objective shall be to meet the liquidity needs of the depositor, and the third objective shall be to achieve a return on the funds under its control. The Government Code does not mandate or define socially responsible investing; however, this concept is marginally addressed in this policy.

The Investment Policy submitted contains no substantive changes from last year. The approved Mendocino County Investment Policy will be accessible to all interested parties on the county website, as well as be provided to all pool participants via email.
