# AMENDMENT TO BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AGREEMENT NO. 17-161

This Amendment to BOS Agreement No. <u>BOS 17-161</u> is entered into this <u>25</u> day of <u>16 percey</u>, 2020 by and between the COUNTY OF MENDOCINO, a political subdivision of the State of California, hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY" and <u>Nacht & Lewis</u>, hereinafter referred to as "CONTRACTOR".

WHEREAS, BOS Agreement No. 17-161 was entered into on December 19, 2017; and

WHEREAS, upon execution of this document by the Chair of the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors and Nacht & Lewis, this document will become part of the aforementioned contract and shall be incorporated therein; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of CONTRACTOR and COUNTY to extend the termination date set out in the original BOS Agreement No. <u>17-161</u>, from <u>June 30</u>, <u>2021</u> to <u>June 30</u>, <u>2023</u>; and

WHEREAS, COUNTY has requested additional services to perform a detailed energy analysis of the Mendocino County SB 844 new jail facility currently under design and CONTRACTOR has provided a detailed proposal for these additional services that is acceptable to the COUNTY,

NOW, THEREFORE, we agree as follows:

- 1. The termination date set out in the original BOS Agreement No. <u>17-161</u> will be extended from <u>June 30, 2021 to June 30, 2023</u>; and
- 2. The Definition of Services (Exhibit A) will be modified to include the detailed energy analysis described in the attached proposal; and
- 3. The compensation payable to the Contractor shall be increased from \$2,910,000 to \$2,957,730 for the term of this agreement.


All other terms and conditions of BOS Agreement No. <u>17-161</u> shall remain in full force and effect.

### **Scope of Services**

#### **Project Location:**

951 Low Gap Road Ukiah, CA 95482

#### Scope of Services:

- 1. Provide a detailed energy analysis of the approximately 22,000 SF Mendocino County SB844 new jail facility currently under design.
- 2. The study will determine annual energy costs associated with mechanical system alternates to the current design to allow for an all-electric system.
- 3. Measures to be included in the energy analysis computer simulation:
  - a. The current base case with packaged gas / electric air conditioning units and a central gas boiler providing hot water to terminal reheat boxes.
  - b. A geothermal ground source heat pump option with a large vertical well field for heat extraction and dissipation connected to individual heat pump units throughout the building.
  - c. A typical water-source heat pump option that will not have the large cost of the well field, but instead will use a closed-circuit fluid cooler for heat dissipation and a heat pump boiler for heat addition.
  - d. An air-source heat pump system that will replace the current units with heat pumps and the current boiler with a heat pump boiler.
  - e. The study will be performed both with an Exterior Insulation Finish System (EIFS) at the exterior perimeter walls and without insulation.
- 4. In each case the annual energy use and annual energy cost for the measure will be reported. These values can be used by others to determine the size of a photovoltaic field to offset the energy consumed.

5. Cost estimating will be performed to determine the estimated construction cost variance from the baseline cost of the current design for each of the alternate systems.

**Deliverables:** One (1) 8 x 11 hard copy draft of the Energy Study Report for County review and comment, and one (1) hard copy Final Draft for the Energy Study Report. Electronic copy, in PDF format, will be provided for the draft and final draft reports.

**Additional Services not Included:** The following services and items are not included in this proposal and may require additional compensation if, and when such services are requested:

- 1. Additional mechanical, electrical or architectural alternates to be studied.
- 2. Benchmarking the results to California Energy Code, ASHRAE 90.1, or Energy Star standards.
- 3. Diagrams, engineered drawings, or system design of the alternates studied (we will provide a well field layout diagram to test fit available space).
- 4. Work involved in securing utility company rebates.
- 5. Meetings in Ukiah.

#### Compensation:

Compensation for professional services shall be in the form of a fixed fee in the amount of \$47,730.00. The fee breakdown is provided below. Payment shall be made monthly in accordance with the percentage of completion.
