ORDINANCE OF THE MENDOCINO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS ADDING CHAPTER 10A.18 – INDUSTRIAL HEMP CULTIVATION PILOT PROGRAM TO THE MENDOCINO COUNTY CODE

This Ordinance adds a new Chapter 10A.18 – Industrial Hemp Cultivation Pilot Program to Title 10A – Agriculture of the Mendocino County Code. This chapter establishes a pilot program that will allow for a limited number of industrial hemp cultivation sites in the unincorporated area of Mendocino County. Persons interested in cultivating industrial hemp must participate in a request for proposals process; persons submitting the highest scoring proposals may apply for a license under Chapter 10A.18. Chapter 10A.18 contains certain standards for hemp cultivation and includes enforcement measures for noncompliance with the provisions of the chapter, including nuisance abatement, administrative penalties, and any other applicable remedy. The provisions of Chapter 10A.18 would expire on December 31, 2022.
