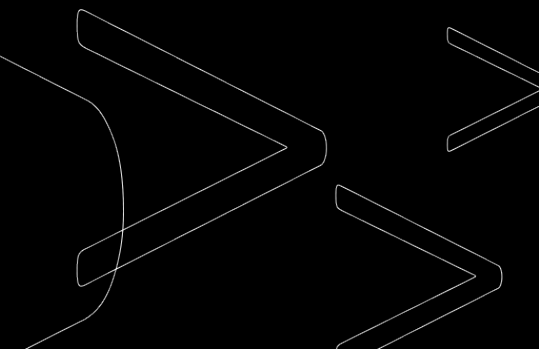


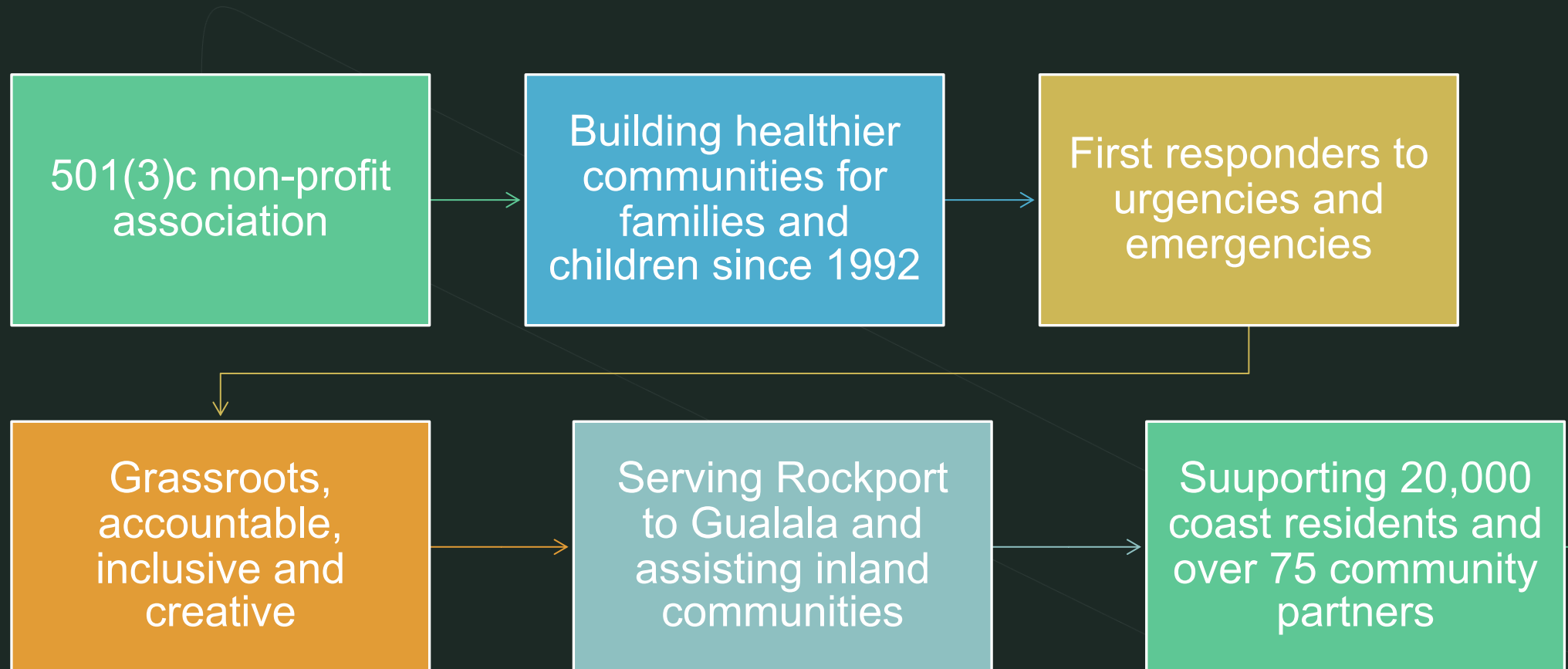

Why We Need Your Help!

MCCF Hope Mobile Van will allow increased enrollment in vital County Services. MCCF Hope Mobile Van will be the bookmobile of hope, solutions and access. We know this will work. We have been doing it for 30 years. We need funding to keep our doors open to serve our community.



■ MCCF is requesting \$100,000: an investment of \$5 per coast resident or \$1.25 per county resident so we can serve the North Coast and our County by providing access, support, and effective and accountable solutions and equity to our communities.

Think of us as a bookmobile of hope and help. We have 20,000 residents on the coast and 15,000 live between Rockport and Elk. We can bring resources to the South Coast as well.
