RESOLUTION OF THE MENDOCINO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AUTHORIZING THE MENDOCINO COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH DEPARTMENT - ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH (LOCAL ENFORCEMENT AGENCY) TO APPLY FOR ENFORCEMENT ASSISTANCE GRANTS ANNUALLY FOR THE NEXT FIVE YEARS

WHEREAS, funds totaling \$1.5 million dollars have been established by Public Resources Code section 43230 for Fiscal Years (FY) 2022-23 through 2026-27, and are available from the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery for grants to Local Enforcement Agencies to support solid waste facility permit and inspection programs; and

WHEREAS, the Mendocino County Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) is eligible for funding in the amount of approximately \$19,265 from LEA Grant EA-33 (FY 2022-23), with money being used to pay part of the cost of one full-time employee working in the County's solid waste facility permit and inspection program (LEA).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors authorizes the submittal of an annual application to the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery for annual Enforcement Assistance Grants for a period of five (5) years.

Furthermore, the Public Health Director, or designee, is authorized and empowered to execute in the name of Mendocino County all necessary applications, contracts, agreements and amendments for the purpose of securing grant funds and to implement and carry out the purposes specified in the application as per County Policy 25 "Grant Applications and Contracts" Section "Existing Grant Renewals and Amendments".
