RESOLUTION NO. 22-150

RESOLUTION OF THE MENDOCINO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS IN SUPPPORT OF SENATE CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT 10

WHEREAS, the U.S. Supreme Courts decision to overturn *Roe v. Wade* disregards the human right to bodily autonomy; and

WHEREAS, Restrictions to an individual's reproductive freedom result in disproportionate harm to people of poverty and people of color; and

WHEREAS, The California Constitution declares that defending life and liberty, acquiring, possessing, and protecting property, and pursuing and obtaining safety, happiness, and privacy are inalienable rights, and that a person may not be deprived of life, liberty, or property without due process of law or equal protection of the laws. Existing law, the Reproductive Privacy Act, declares that every individual possesses a fundamental right of privacy with respect to personal reproductive decisions and prohibits the state from denying or interfering with a person's right to choose or obtain an abortion before viability of the fetus, or when the abortion is necessary to protect the life or health of the person; and

WHEREAS, Senate Constitutional Amendment would amend the California Constitution to prohibit the state from denying or interfering with an individual's reproductive freedom in their most intimate decisions, which includes their fundamental right to choose to have an abortion and their fundamental right to choose or refuse contraceptives.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors fully supports the passage of Senate Constitutional Amendment 10 which will be on the November 2022 ballot.
