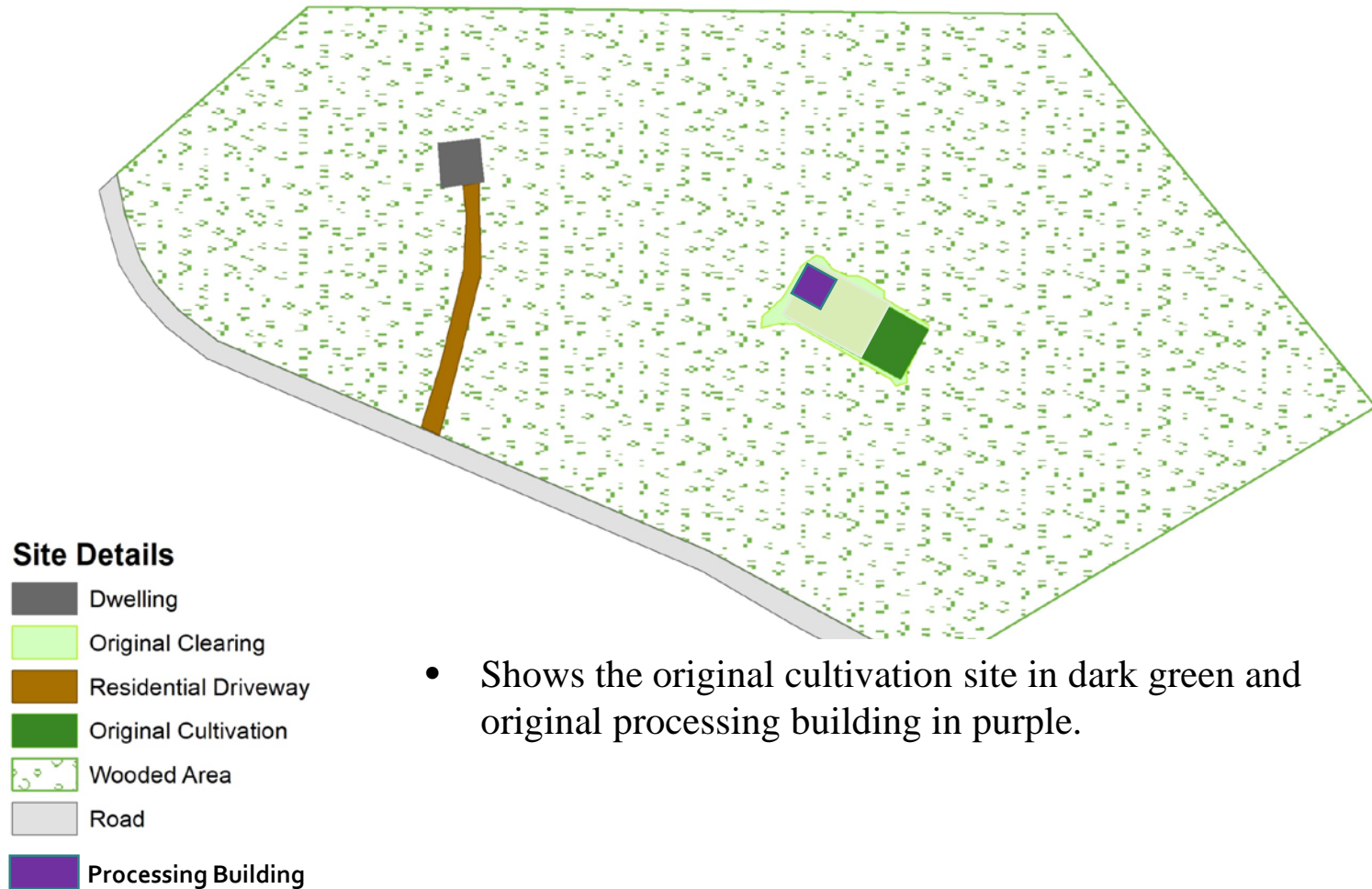
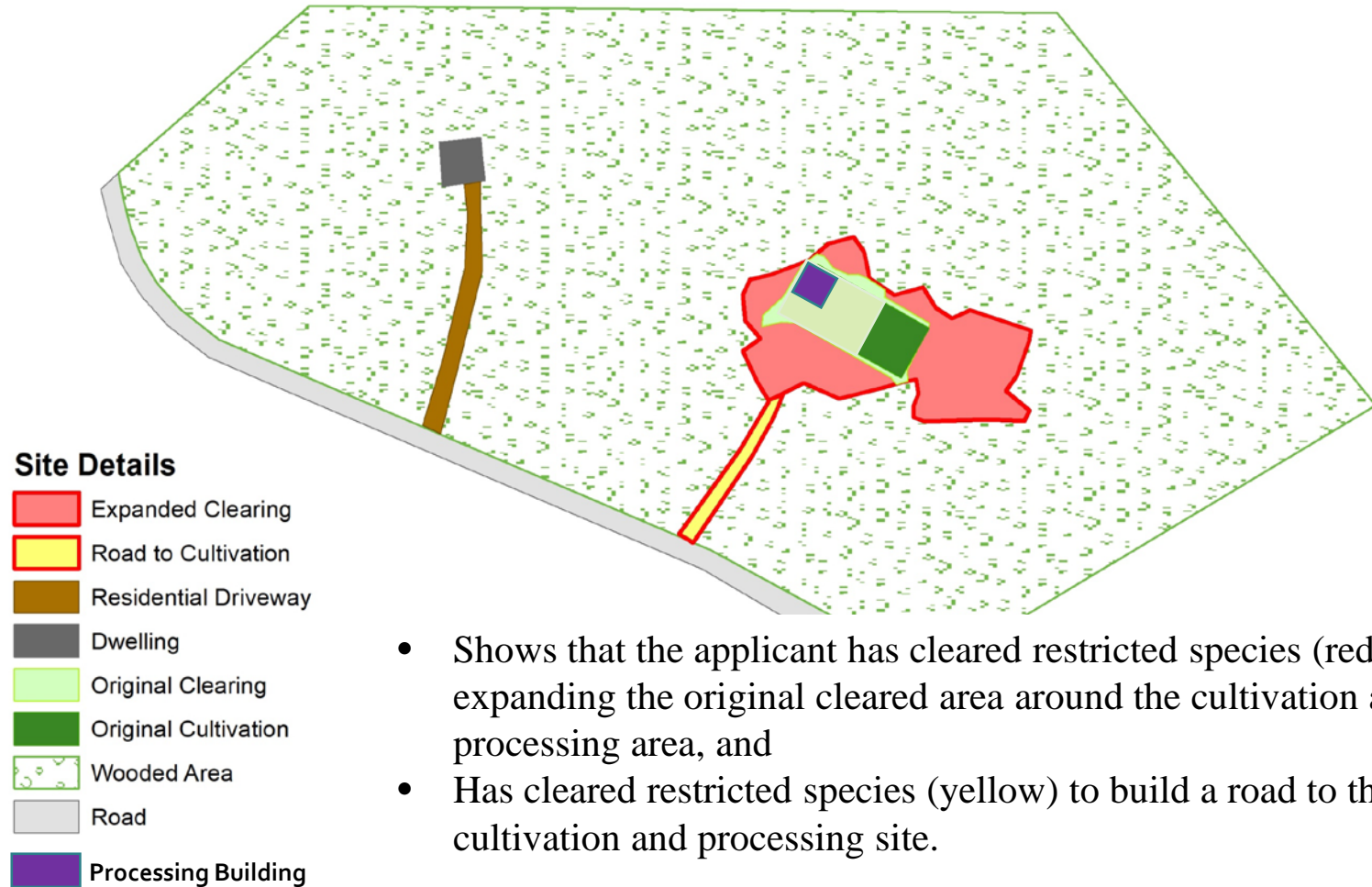

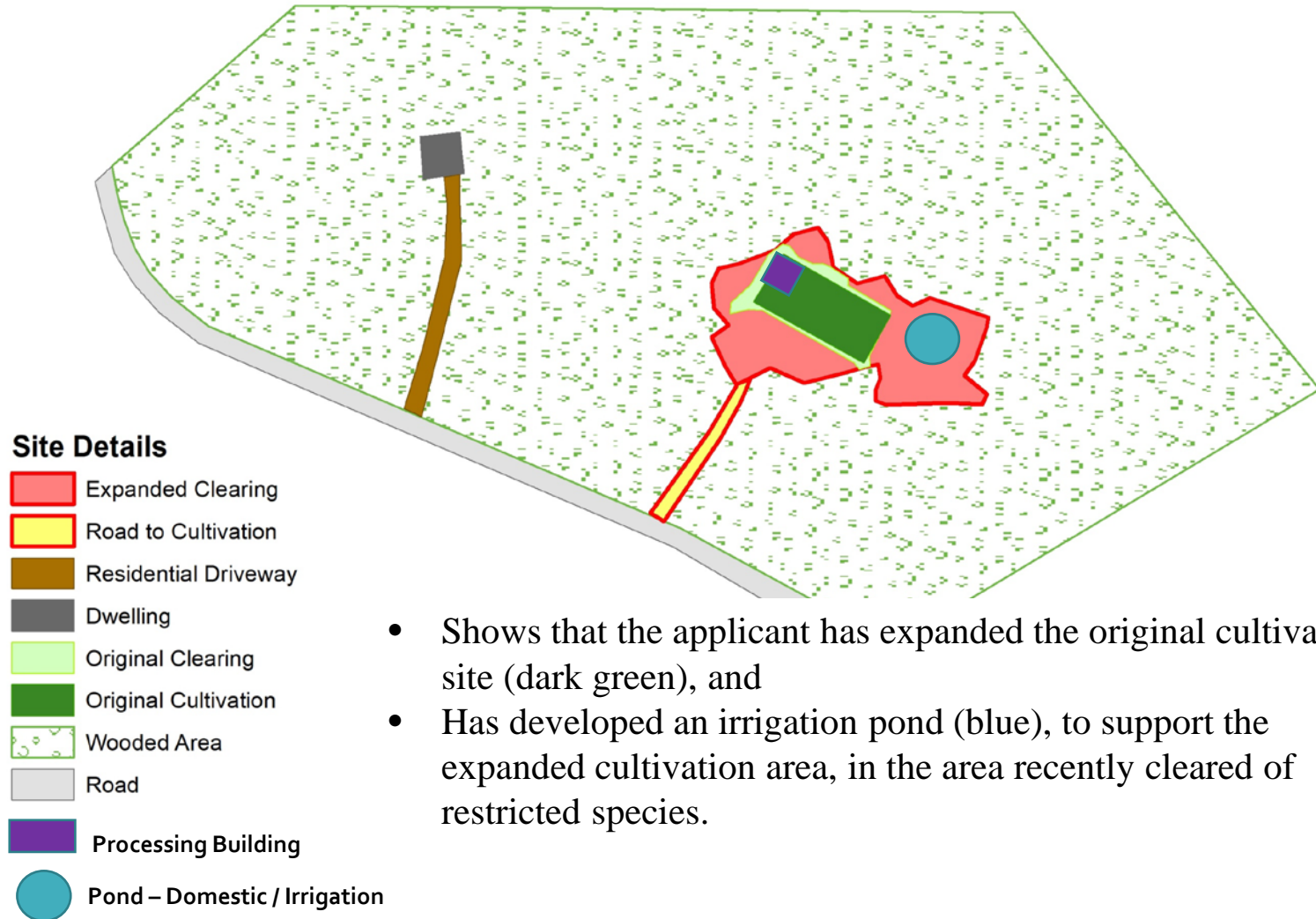
- Shows the original cultivation site in dark green and original processing building in purple.

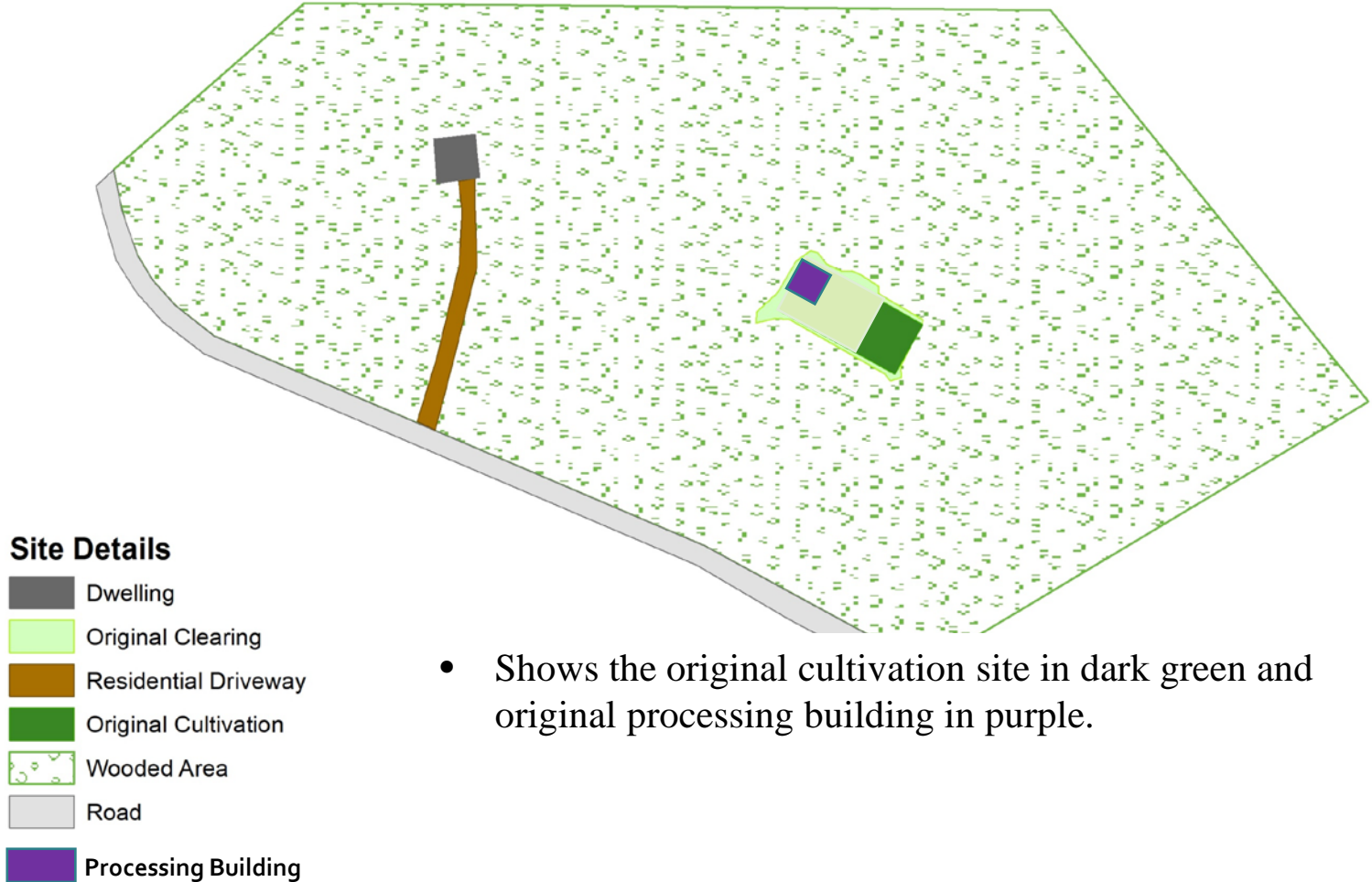

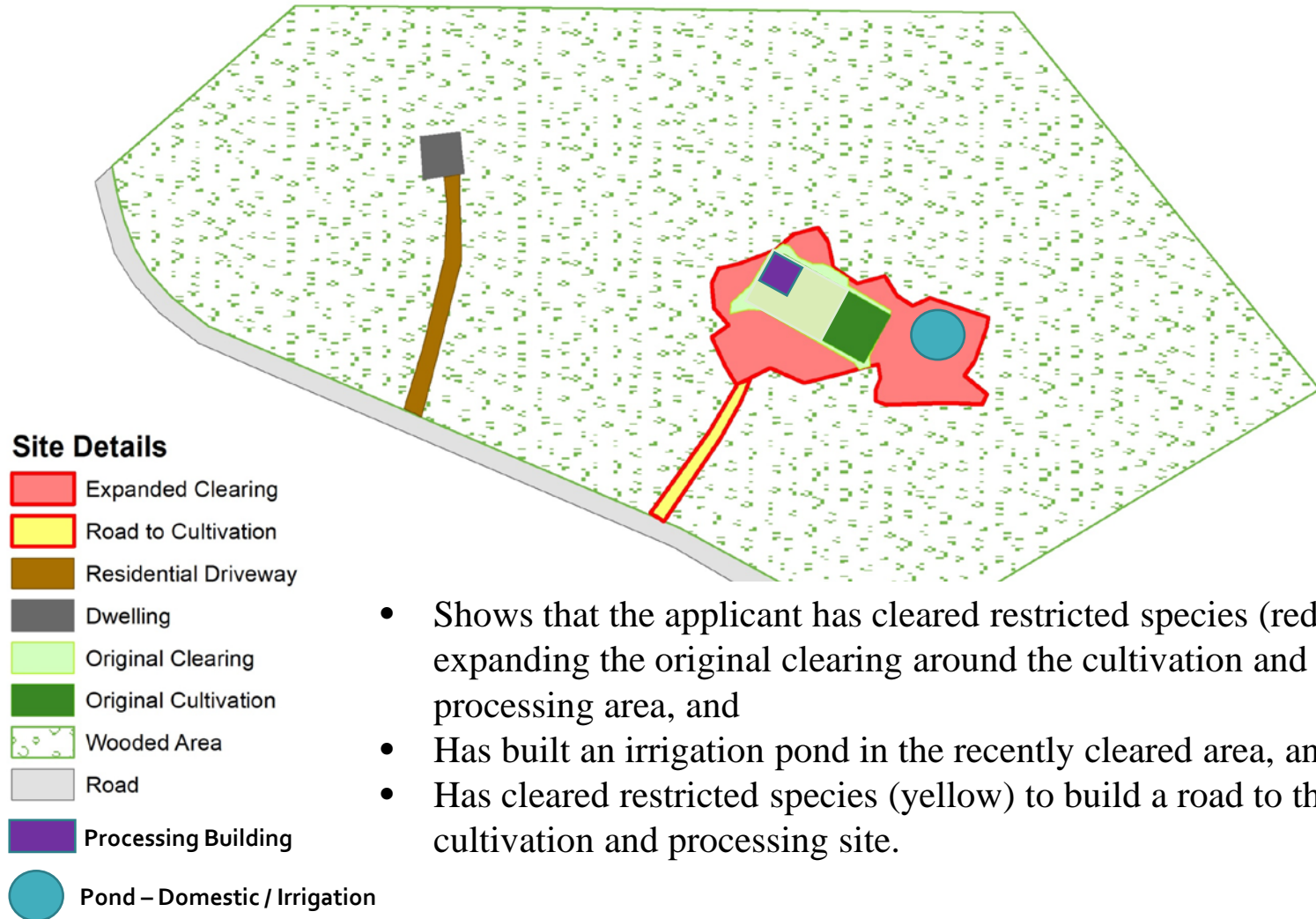
