• Forsythe Creek Bridge Replacement on Reeves Canyon Road, County Road 219, M.P. 0.46: MCDoT replacement of the structurally deficient railcar/timber bridge. Pursuant to Board Resolution Number (No.) 16-045 (April 5, 2016) bids for MCDoT Contract No. 160022, for the above referenced project, were opened as scheduled on Thursday, May 4, 2017. Mercer-Fraser Company of Eureka, California, was deemed the apparent "low bidder" for this project with a bid of \$1,642,978.00. The Engineer's Estimate for the contract was \$1,511,322.20.

• 2017 Corrective Maintenance Overlay and Base Repairs Project on Various County Maintained Roads: Pursuant to Board Resolution No. 17-035 (March 20, 2017), bids for MCDoT Contract No. 170001, 2017 Overlays & Base Repairs on Various Mendocino County Roads were opened as scheduled on Thursday, May 11, 2017. Granite Construction Company of Ukiah, California, was deemed the apparent "low bidder" for this project with a base bid of \$1,852,202.50. The Engineer's Estimate for the contract was \$1,651,165.00. Argonaut Constructors had been the apparent low bidders but withdrew under California Public Contract Code Section 5100 to 5107 due to a mistake filling out the form.
