REQUEST FOR BOARD ACTION TO AMEND CURRENT CANNABIS CULTIVATION ORDINANCE

Dear Members of the Board of Supervisors,

We, the undersigned property owners of Woodyglen Lane / Boonville Road strongly believe that the current ordinance is in need of changes to fairly represent the needs of the citizens of Mendocino County. We respectfully request that the Board consider the following points to immediately revise the current ordinance so that it allows cultivation within reasonable parameters for growers, and does not adversely impact the health, safety, welfare, and cultural fabric of existing neighborhoods.

- 1. Support for an opt-out provision for commercial growing in neighborhoods with majority opposition to commercial cultivation.
- 2. Support for a "good-neighbor provision" where commercial growing that crosses other parcels and negatively impacts them would require a use-permit, variance, or some other approval mechanism. For example, commercial operations that have negative impacts to private roads, bridges, etc. are currently allowed to continue degrading that infrastructure without consideration for the rights of the owners' properties they cross.
- 3. Attempted transfers from the Coastal Zone shall be excluded from the ordinance. As pointed out by Mr. Gonzalez of Building and Planning, the original environmental study did not include Coastal Zone impacts, therefore any transfers allowed from the Coastal Zone would undermine the study.
- 4. Submittal of a cultivation application to the Ag Dept should not tie the hands of code enforcement to act on violations.
