RESOLUTION OF THE MENDOCINO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AUTHORIZING MENDOCINO COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT TO RECEIVE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SUSTAINABLE COMMUNITY-BASED TRANSPORTATION PLANNING GRANT FUNDS FOR THE "ORCHARD AVENUE EXTENSION FEASIBILITY STUDY" (UKIAH AREA)

WHEREAS, the Mendocino County Department of Transportation (MCDoT) submitted an application to the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) to apply for Sustainable Community-Based Transportation Planning Grant (CBTP) funds to conduct the "Orchard Avenue Extension Feasibility Study"; and

WHEREAS, MCDoT recognizes the need to identify alternatives for the future northerly extension of Orchard Avenue, an important local roadway; and

WHEREAS, an extension of the current Orchard Avenue roadway will create a direct route, reduce travel distances, and provide an alternate emergency access in case of closure of parallel U.S. Highway 101; and

WHEREAS, the envisioned roadway resulting from this feasibility study will provide a critically needed, additional north-south transportation corridor for the greater Ukiah area, and will improve circulation and connectivity of local roads; and

WHEREAS, this project supports the region's Blueprint Planning efforts which identified the need for improved road infrastructure in the Ukiah area; and is supported by the Regional Transportation Planning Agency; and

WHEREAS, on April 21, 2017, the "Orchard Avenue Extension Feasibility Study" grant application was awarded by Caltrans (\$150,944 Grant, plus \$19,556 Local Match, Project Total \$170,500); and

WHEREAS, conditions of grant approval require a local resolution from the County of Mendocino's government board authorizing staff to enter into a contract with Caltrans.
