EDFC's Foundations

- Provide economic development coordination and support for:

EDFC Past Performance

- Lent over \$6.3 million in loans over the last 23 years, current portfolio is \$1.66 Million outstanding.
- Leveraged \$6.3 Million with over \$20 Million in private capital
- Brought over \$2.5 Million in grant funding into Mendocino County prior to June 30, 2018.
- Direct Public Offering, Meat Processing Plant Feasibility Study, Access to Capital events, economic summits, Share Space





2018-2019 Economic Development Highlights

- Economic Summit on January 31st
- Successful grant applications: \$1.3 Million
- Current Outstanding Grant Applications: \$423,500
- Digital Infrastructure Planning and Implementation



2016 Survey of 10 Successful Borrowers

- One of ten was start-up financing, existing businesses ranged from 5 to over 60 years in business
- All surveyed borrowers realized increases in annual business revenue after receiving a loan, with the increase ranging from \$100,000 to over \$7.2 million
- Business owners' personal incomes increased by an average \$16,111
- An average of 30.9 jobs were created or retained per loan





EDFC Loan Products

- Credit Builders (>\$10,000)
- Small Microloan (>\$25,000)
- Large Microloan (>\$50,000)
- Small Business Loan (>\$250,000)
 - Interest rates start at 6% fixed simple APR.
 - Able to provide lower interest for disaster or digital infrastructure related loans under \$50k.





Next Steps for Digital Infrastructure

- Complete at least three more feasibility studies and find funding
- Determine feasibility of serving at low income families in Mendocino County
