## AN ORDINANCE ADDING SECTION 2.38.020 TO CHAPTER 2.38 TO TITLE 2 OF THE MENDOCINO COUNTY CODE ENTITLED "RESERVE DEPUTY SHERIFF – DESIGNATED AND NON-DESIGNATED"

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Mendocino ordains as follows:

Section 2.38.020 is added to Chapter 2.38 is added to Title 2 of the Mendocino County Code to read as follows:

## Section 2.38.020 – Reserve Deputy Sheriff – Designated and Non-Designated.

- (A) The Sheriff or his or her authorized designee, has the authority to select and appoint any reserve deputy sheriff as a "designated" reserve deputy sheriff as provided by California Penal Code Section 830.6(a)(2). The authority of the reserve deputy sheriff so designated includes the full powers and duties of a peace officer as provided by California Penal Code section 830.1.
- (B) Any reserve deputy sheriff not appointed as a "designated" reserve deputy sheriff as provided in subsection A of this section is a "non-designated" reserve deputy sheriff as provided by California Penal Code section 830.6(a)(1). The authority of a nondesignated reserve deputy sheriff shall extend only for the duration of the reserve deputy's specific assignment.
