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IN-HOME SUPPORTIVE SERVICES (IHSS) PROVIDERS OVERVIEW

- Providers deliver domestic related and personal care to recipients of IHSS
- Providers are employed by recipients
- Providers are paid by the State of California
- Provider registries are maintained by the county of residence

BECOMING AN IHSS PROVIDER

- Complete an application packet
 - Social Security Card
 - Government issued photo identification
- Background Check
- Attend Orientation
- Interview with recipients

- Registry Option





- Domestic Related
 - Housecleaning
 - Meal Prep/Meal Cleanup
- Personal Care
 - Grooming & Bathing
 - Feeding

- Para-Medical
 - Insulin Injections

- Protective Supervision
 - 24 Hour Care Plan



COMPENSATION

- Hourly Wage \$12 per hour
- Sick Leave
- Travel Time
- Wait Time



ELECTRONIC TIMESHEET SYSTEM

- Timesheets completed on computer or telephone
- Providers and recipients have easy access to timesheets
- Expedite timesheet processing
 - Reduce errors
 - Timely approval
 - Reduces duplication of claimed hours with multiple providers

PROVIDERS COUNTYWIDE

- 1,631 Providers
- 124 IHSS registry providers
- 1,923,775 Approved hours of care
- 1,774 Eligible IHSS recipients





- Supports IHSS recipients remaining in their home
- Helps reduce isolation
- Provides care to those in need maximizing independence
- Reduces hospitalizations
