*An amnesty pathway may allow enrollees to attend a monthly instructional class provided by Mendocino County, to reach compliance, for amnesty pathway enrollees.

*An amnesty pathway may allow immunity from persecution of illegal cannabis cultivation, for people enrolled in the amnesty pathway system, or for current permit applicants.

*An amnesty pathway may allow for a three month grace period, (to come into compliance, or reach compliance) for applicants found out of compliance, or for new applicants, or for people charged with crimes related to illegal cannabis cultivation, provided that they enroll in the amnesty pathway system.

*An amnesty pathway may allow for (a one to three year) carryover of permit costs, for applicants who meet criteria for financial assistance.
