

SUMMARY OF PROPOSED
ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 5.20 OF THE MENDOCINO COUNTY CODE - TAX IMPOSED ON TRANSIENTS

This ordinance amends Chapter 5.20 of the Mendocino County Code, in which a permanent transient occupancy tax is imposed on persons renting, for 30 days or less, a room or rooms in a hotel, motel, inn or similar structure in the unincorporated area, to include spaces at private campgrounds or recreational vehicle parks (not to be imposed on spaces in a State park or any other facility exempt pursuant to state law.)

The ordinance will go into effect only if the tax is approved by a majority of the voters in the unincorporated areas voting on the tax at the next election.

The proposed ordinance is scheduled for adoption on November 19, 2019.
