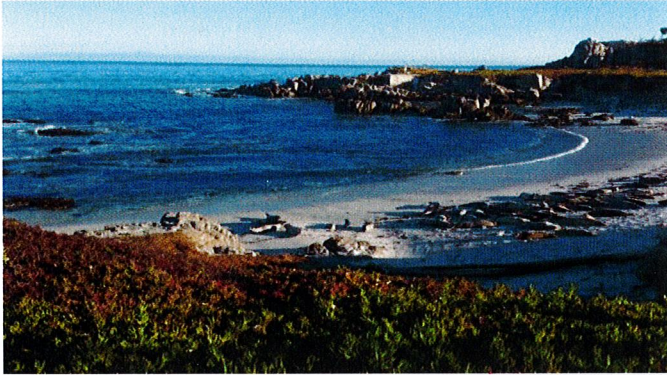


New Prosecutors Academy
