

I reside in Fort Bragg.

A map put out by CA Dept. of Public Health indicates that Mendocino County is among the counties that have reported community transmission of Covid-19 as of 3/20/20. However, Dr Doohan's recent oral report to the Mendocino County Bd. of Supervisors stated that there is no community spread as of 3/20/20. I listened to the entire Board meeting online. Dr. Doohan continues to report in, video and written form, that there is no known community spread of Covid-19 in Mendocino County. Can you please reconcile this seeming inconsistency in reporting to us?

Additionally, Dr. Doohan appears to base her opinion on the personal histories of the handful of actual cases for which positive results have been secured. However, this does not explain the totality of the environment here with all the pending test results for residents who have symptoms but are not yet diagnosed, not to mention those who are untested yet infected, and either do or do not have tell tale symptoms. It appears reasonable to assume under the circumstances that, for example, there are infected people in the Mendocino community that may not have symptoms that are either working at or going to stores for essential supplies that may be spreading the Covid-19 virus.
