Since that data was put up two days ago as indicated in the below link, at least 29 more people have been tested and one person has been released. So is there only one active case in the county?

It was also revealed the the Dpt of Health knows of more cases but since they are staying at home, there is no need for testing.

Having only 300 total tests in three weeks is an unacceptably low level of testing that does not reveal the true extent of infection in the county.

We have to up the game and do much more testing of at least a few thousand people so decisions to let us out of confinement are based and reliable data.

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
