I wanted to speak on the behalf of the local people who want to sport fish.

It's really a subsistence fishery.

It is not entertainment, but the procurement of food.

Many people don't have jobs now, they do have boats, gear and freezers.

They fish every year and fill their freezers and feed their families.

The harbor district has closed the public ramps, but is okay for local people to move the barricades to put their boats in, to fish, if they put them back. Because the harbor master is aware this is subsistence fishing. The harbor master has said this.

Some people have sport boats in the harbor.

This would still protect the community from an onslaught of fishermen coming from out of the area.

People fish off the jetty and off the rocks on the headlands.
