The public is being muted online concerning the PHO leaving the county after issuing a shelterin-place order and the gov.'s recommendation. How does the board of supervisors expect locals to obey orders from someone not residing in the county, who disobeys her own orders and government recommendations, and puts the public at risk while receiving a paycheck? There is no "family emergency" exception which rumors are implying. If she officially moved, perhaps the public should be made aware this is allowable and an exception for all? The public is requesting transparency. The law should apply equally. Is there someone else who is in line to take her place?
