RESOLUTION OF THE MENDOCINO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS APPROVING LIST OF ROAD MAINTENANCE AND REHABILITATION ACCOUNT PROJECTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020-21, FUNDED BY SENATE BILL 1: THE ROAD REPAIR AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF 2017 (NAVARRO AREA)

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and signed into law by the Governor in April 2017, to address the significant transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

WHEREAS, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of Mendocino County are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, Mendocino County must adopt, by resolution, a list of projects proposed to receive funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1, each Fiscal Year (FY), and which must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and

WHEREAS, this is the fourth year Mendocino County is receiving SB 1 funding, which will enable Mendocino County to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation projects for the traveling public that would not have otherwise been possible without SB 1; and

WHEREAS, Mendocino County has undergone a robust public process to ensure public input into our community's transportation priorities, including presenting the project list on page 511 of the FY 2019-20 County Budget and in the Department of Transportation Director's Report at the January 8, 2019, Board of Supervisors Meeting; and

WHEREAS, Mendocino County used a Pavement Management System to develop the SB 1 project list to ensure revenues are being used on the most high-priority and cost-effective projects that also meet the community's priorities for transportation investment; and

WHEREAS, the funding from SB 1 will help Mendocino County maintain and rehabilitate approximately fifteen miles of surfaced roads, and hundreds of similar projects into the future; and

WHEREAS, the 2018 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment found that Mendocino County's streets and roads are in an "at-risk/poor" condition, and SB 1 revenue (estimated at \$100 million) will help us increase the overall quality of our road system, and over the next eighteen years, will bring our streets and roads into a "fair" condition; and

WHEREAS, the SB 1 project list and overall investment in our local streets and roads infrastructure, with a focus on basic maintenance and safety, and using cutting-edge technology, materials and practices, will have significant positive co-benefits statewide.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct; and

2. The Board of Supervisors hereby approves the following list of projects to be funded with Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues:
