As the management team of Ukiah Speedway, we feel that we should provide you with our ideas about opening back up our track in phases. We have seen 4 tracks in the state of California open up in the last few weeks following phases and we feel that we should be able to start off in Phase 1. We live in a rural area where there is a wider area of being able to social distance in Phase 1 and Phase 2. We are a recreational sport and we feel that we need to be looked at.

Phase 1 would consist of allowing 10 cars to be able to practice at Ukiah Speedway. We would only allow 2 people per team which includes a crew member and the driver. Everyone who is in the pits will be wearing masks and gloves, it is mandatory. All participants will have their temperature checked before entering the track and will be asked if they have had any of the symptoms in the last 14 days. If they have, they will not be allowed to enter the track. All trailers with cars will be parked 20 feet apart and all participants will be maintaining 6 feet apart at all times. We will only allow one car at a time on the track so that we can maintain the 6 feet apart. All workers at the facility will be wearing masks and gloves at all times. All bathrooms will be sanitized and cleaned after every use. We will provide a sanitizing station as well.

Phase 2 would consist of allowing us to race while maintaining the same guidelines as Phase 1. We would run one division, with 25 cars max. Each team will be allowed to have 3 crew members plus the driver. Everyone who is in the pits will be wearing masks and gloves, it is mandatory. All participants will have their temperature checked before entering the track and will be asked if they have had any of the symptoms in the last 14 days. If they have, they will not be allowed to enter the track. All trailers with cars will be parked 20 feet apart and all participants will be maintaining 6 feet apart at all times. We will only allow one car at a time on the track so that we can maintain the 6 feet apart. All workers at the facility will be wearing masks and gloves at all times. All bathrooms will be sanitized and cleaned after every use. We will provide a sanitizing station as well.

Phase 3 would consist of racing with more divisions and allowing the grandstands to open. We would allow 100 people in the grandstands with the all fans maintaining 3 feet apart. We would allow teams to have up to 6 crew members including the driver and everyone would be screened before entering. We would do the same for the grandstands. All bathrooms will be sanitized and cleaned after every use. We will provide a sanitizing station as well.

Phase 4 would consist of being back to full action with the grandstands open and the pit area open to full potential. We would run all divisions with no limitations on people. Grandstands would be fully operational with concessions and beer booth open.

We have seen one track open up this week with following the guidelines on phase 3 for their practicing sessions. We feel that we need to take it one step a time and with slow progression. Although, our county and surrounding counties rely on Ukiah Speedway as their place to race and sadly during this time, they are unable to do much of anything. We wanted to present you with these ideas because we need to start taking care of our racers. We are part of the recreational sport section, and we feel that we should be allowed to open with following all these phases.
