RESOLUTION OF THE MENDOCINO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS REQUESTING THAT THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION GRANT ITS PERMISSION FOR THE ROUND VALLEY HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION PARADE IN COVELO, CALIFORNIA, PURSUANT TO THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND CALIFORNIA HIGHWAY PATROL'S JOINT POLICY GUIDELINES FOR SPECIAL EVENTS ON STATE CONVENTIONAL HIGHWAY RIGHTS-OF-WAYS

WHEREAS, the Round Valley Unified School District wishes to hold a parade in connection with the celebration of the graduation of the Round Valley High School's class of 2020; and

WHEREAS, said parade will be held on Friday, July 19, 2020, between 3:00 P.M. and 4:00 P.M., and will commence at Howard and Main Streets, continuing on Highway 162 through the town of Covelo, turning at Eberle Street off of Highway 162; and

WHEREAS, in order for the parade to be held, the Round Valley Unified School District needs to seek support from the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors, pursuant to the Department of Transportation and California Highway Patrol's Joint Policy Guidelines for Special Events on State Conventional Highway Rights-of-Ways, to conduct a parade.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors does hereby support the Round Valley High School Class of 2020 Graduation Parade and seeks the support and cooperation of any involved agencies.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors does hereby state that any liabilities and responsibilities shall rest with the parade sponsors.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mendocino County Board of Supervisors requests the State Department of Transportation to give their permission pursuant to the Department of Transportation and California Highway Patrol's Joint Policy Guidelines for Special Events on State Conventional Rights of Way for the Round Valley High School Class of 2020 Graduation Parade to be held in Covelo, California, on Highway 162, on July 19, 2020.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THE Clerk of the Board of Supervisors is directed to forward copies of this Resolution to the Caltrans District Permit Coordinator (Eureka), the California Highway Patrol, and the Round Valley Unified School District.
