EDFC, in an email exchange with the County, requested (1) that the confidentiality of EDFC's clients be honored, and (2) asked that the Board of Supervisors revisit the scope to evaluate whether it is beyond their intention. EDFC never indicated and there was never intent to refuse to cooperate with the assessment.

EDFC welcomes the opportunity to get back to what we do best which is to support the success of locally owned small businesses.
