Dear Carmel,

The Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Funding (CESF) Program has recently released their local solicitation for grant funds for Fiscal Year 2020. The application is due May 29, 2020 by 11:59 p.m. (Eastern Standard Time). This grant is \$69,733 and the funds are used to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the coronavirus. This is a one-time grant opportunity with a short turn-around time frame.

The application is being prepared this week. However, there is not time to send this request to the Board of Supervisors to meet the May 29, 2020 filing deadline.

Under County Policy #25, Section One, Number 4, if there is a time restriction that limits the department from going to the Board, the CEO may approve signing as long as the department takes the item to the Board of Supervisors at their next available meeting.

I am requesting your approval for my signature on the BJA CESF application for federal year 2020/2021 so we may submit it and meet the deadline and receive the funding.
