I feel as though we we have sufficient air flow in salon as if it were outside minus the wind gusts. I'm no longer receiving edd and and as you know it's extremely difficult to get in touch with them, also the 667 a week is not near what I usually make therefore I can't pay my bills on that allowance. That being said, please take into consideration our dynamics and allow us to reopen. I believe that each business situation is different and should be evaluated individually with a plan of action. This is a small town with only a few salons here. I beg you to discuss this at the table. Also if me and my daughter (the other stylist) need to work separate days we can do that to.
