Dear board members,

My name is Jon Orantes. My wife Vanessa and I have lived at 3343 and 3335 Ridgewood rd (Old Boy Scout rd) for 21 years. We have had minimum issues with parcel deliveries, emergency services, and other such visitors finding our correct address locations.

We believe the name change would cause confusion to a situation that is not currently broken. To correct the single duplicate address would be a more appropriate remedy that avoids creating needless confusion and risk for over 30 families.

In our time here, the only issues we have had with our addresses have been related to property line adjustments that we have done with neighboring properties. When a property line adjustment occurs it can cause you to be assigned new APN's, which lead to numerous points of confusion and require diligent follow-up with related entities, such as mortgage companies, county property tax department, and so on.

I would anticipate that many issues would arise, per parcel, if you were to enact this change. Each affected family would be at risk of:

- Not being located in a timely manner during an emergency
- Incorrectly recorded land deeds
- Confusion and delinquency on property tax payments
- Loss of homeowners insurance
- All billing and banking must be redone

All of the above is exacerbated by the COVID-19 crisis making contacting various agencies and entities nearly impossible.

Alternatively, you could address the one single issue of one duplicate address.
