I am a cannabis cultivator in District 3 with a Provisional License from CDFA.

**I strongly agree with all of the MCA recommendations and respectfully encourage you to make the recommended changes to the Mendocino County Cannabis Program.**

**I am very concerned that there is no assurance I will be eligible for an annual license before the state is no longer able to renew my provisional license.**

If I'm conducting agricultural activities on land that is zoned for agricultural uses including row and field crops, nurseries, etc., then why shouldn't I be eligible for CEQA compliance and a state Annual License.

My operations should not be treated differently than other agriculture. Cannabis should be treated as agriculture in Mendocino County.
