

EMERGENCY ACCESS ROUTES FOR THE SHERWOOD CORRIDOR UP TO 2018


Prior to 2018, the official Evacuation Map for the Sherwood Corridor- Brooktrails & Region. In addition to Sherwood Road, the main evacuation route, there were 4 additional emergency routes



SHERWOOD CORRIDOR EVACUATION MAP 2019

All 4 Emergency Access Routes Eliminated Leaving Only One-Way-In-And-Out





Two Emergency Access Routes Secured FIRCO and Willits Creek

BTCSD & Mendocino County Supervisors' Unanimous Support

Sherwood Firewise has secured Cal Fire funding to clear the Willits Creek route

Annual Maintenance Costs to be collected through Assessment on Property Taxes

Sherwood Firewise has secured funding from Cal Fire (\$447,000*), Community Foundation of Mendocino County (\$10,000) and pro bono legal services from Kronick (> \$50,000) to assist the County with setting up the new Zone

Engineer's Report is needed to make an Apportionment Determination

NOTE – The FIRCO Route was used extensively during the recent Oak Fire incident leaving Sherwood Road open for Evacuation
