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## AMENDMENT TO COUNTY OF MENDOCINO PURCHASING AGENT AGREEMENT NO. PM 20-004

This Amendment to Agreement No. <u>PM 20-004</u> is entered into this <u>11th</u> day of <u>August</u>, 2020, by and between the COUNTY OF MENDOCINO, a political subdivision of the State of California, hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY" and <u>Fiber Channels, Inc.</u>, hereinafter referred to as "CONTRACTOR".

WHEREAS, Agreement No. PM 20-004 was entered into on June 3, 2020; and

WHEREAS, upon execution of this document by the County of Mendocino and the Contractor, this document will become part of the aforementioned contract and shall be incorporated therein; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of CONTRACTOR and COUNTY to increase the total compensation payable set out in the original Agreement No. <u>PM 20-004</u>, from \$22,000 to \$44,500; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of CONTRACTOR and COUNTY to amend the original services and scope of work provided by CONTRACTOR set out in the original Agreement No. <u>PM 20-004</u>, to include additional services as described in Attachment A-1.

NOW, THEREFORE, we agree as follows:

- 1. The total compensation payable set out in the original Agreement No. <u>PM 20-004</u> will be increased from \$22,000 to \$44,500.
- 2. The scope of services set out in original Agreement No. <u>PM 20-004</u> shall be amended to include the additional tasks as described in Attachment A-1.

All other terms and conditions of Agreement No. PM 20-004 shall remain in full force and effect.

## SCOPE OF SERVICES

Using the data collected to date, and updated as required by changes or new developments within the county and the designated communities, the scope of services that will be provided by the consultant shall include the following for Mendocino Project #2-- Branscomb, Leggett, Piercy, Westport, Cleone, Fort Bragg, Mendocino, Little River, Albion, Elk, Manchester, Point Arena, Anchor Bay, Gualala, Comptche, Philo, and Boonville.

- 1. Requirements definition and recommendations for Project #2 to link to Project #1 footprint (to avoid settling on a solution that won't provide a seamless, integrated solution for all communities in the county);
- 2. Identification, evaluation, pricing, and a recommended solution for the near and long-term for each of the designated communities including:
  - a. Cost vs. benefit analysis;
  - b. Implementation scheduling,
  - c. Presentations to the stakeholders in each community in support of the proposed solution.

## Deliverables from this effort will include:

- 1. A network design including an overview of the proposed, overall county broadband network infrastructure;
- A recommended budget based on an engineered solution capable of being acquired, implemented, and made operationally capable of delivering the internet service performance levels defined in the grant request; (100 Mbps down/100 Mbps up) for each of the designated communities;
- 3. A phased implementation plan and project schedule; and
- 4. Write-ups for the grant application.
