Her positive energy makes her a great fundraiser, not only helping FOCCL raise funds for the 2003 renovation of the historic Gillmore Building that today houses Coast Community Library, but, again in 2017, helping to raise over \$400,000 for the library building's seismic retrofit. Her great, wry sense of humor and understanding of human nature I'm sure contribute to her success as a fundraiser.

I love that this proclamation honors Pearl Watts for her dedication to the public good because this is exactly what she represents, she talks the talk and walks the walk for the people of our county through her continual support of the community library and all libraries.
