"Redwood Valley Water District had many chances to be a part of Russian River Flood Control and other local water efforts. It has opted to go it alone which has left it without a secure water source. Redwood Valley has a very big problem with securing enough water just for the houses in our town.

It seems inappropriate to spend the fire survivor settlement money on the sheriff's department.

I'd rather see it go to fuel load reduction efforts. Maybe even burying some of the central power transmission lines to lower the impact of PSPS shutoffs."
